Which Christ, all ages' Lord and Guide, In these last days has sanctified.

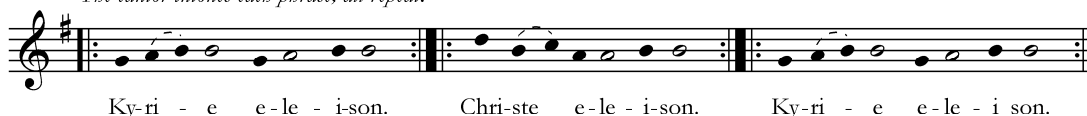
More sparing, therefore, let us make the words we speak, the food we take,
